Buffalo Medical Group's MyBMGChart Now Available on Android-Enabled Devices

(Williamsville, NY) – Capitalizing on the initial enhancement of hand-held device mobility made last spring, Buffalo Medical Group patients can now view their MyBMGChart medical information on their Android-enabled devices.

In April 2011, BMG launched the extremely successful iPhone application for MyBMGChart, and now adds the second major smartphone platform.

The secure Android application enables patients to access many of the features available on MyBMGChart such as test results, view upcoming and past appointments, and receive messages and health reminders sent from their providers.

The app is available on Android devices free of charge and can be accessed through the Android Market. BMG patients may click on the "App" icon and search for "MyChart" and then click on the MyChart icon to download. Once downloaded, patients click the information button to find Buffalo Medical Group and proceed to log in with their user ID and password they created when they signed up for MyBMGChart.

BMG patients must have an active MyBMGChart account to use this app. If they do not have an account, they should contact their physician's office to request an access code. Just like MyBMGChart, the Android app is secure and utilizes the highest standards of online security to protect patient information.

More than 28,500 Buffalo Medical Group patients are now enrolled in MyBMGChart, the patient portal in BMG's electronic medical record system. It was unveiled in 2008 to enable the Group's patients to access their own health information from anywhere in the world an Internet connection is available.
