

Female Urologist to Join Buffalo Medical Group

WILLIAMSVILLE, NY – Valerie L. Burkhard, MD, who specializes in adult and pediatric urology, will join Buffalo Medical Group, PC, in August. She is one of only two female urologists in Western New York, and is affiliated with all major hospitals in Western New York.

A graduate of Johns Hopkins University, Dr. Burkhard earned her medical degree at the University at Buffalo (UB) School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. She was awarded the Dean's Academic Achievement Award for Excellence in her second year at UB, and received the Buffalo Surgical Society Prize in Surgery in her third and fourth years.

Dr. Burkhard completed a five-year residency in urology at UB and affiliated hospitals, and served as Chief Resident in Urology during her final year. She also has specialty training in endoscopy, laparoscopy, microscopy, robotics, and open surgical techniques.

A clinical assistant instructor at UB, she is a member of the American Urological Association, American Medical Association, American Medical Women's Association, Society of Women in Urology, and the Endourological Society.

Dr. Burkhard has authored or co-authored articles on her research for numerous medical journals and publications.

Dr. Burkhard will see patients at 85 High Street, Buffalo; 295 Essjay Road, Williamsville, and 3345 Southwestern Boulevard, Orchard Park.
