

BMG Names Director of Radiation Medicine

WILLIAMSVILLE, NY - Moneer A. Khalil, MD, has been named Director of Radiation Medicine by Buffalo Medical Group, PC. Dr. Khalil, who joined BMG on July 1, is board certified in therapeutic radiology by the American Board of Radiology, and served as Director of the Buffalo Radiation Oncology Center in Williamsville for the last 14 years.

Before joining the Buffalo Radiation Oncology Center in 1995, Dr. Khalil was director of Radiation Oncology at the Sisters of Charity Hospital Seton Building.

He is a member of the American Society of Therapeutic Radiologists and the American Society of Clinical Oncology.
