

## **Cardiologist Dr. Andrew Luisi to Join Buffalo Medical Group**

He earned his medical degree in 1997 at the University at Buffalo (UB) School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, where he completed residency training in Internal Medicine and Nuclear Medicine, and a fellowship in Cardiovascular Diseases.

Dr. Luisi is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology and the American Society of Nuclear Cardiology, and a member of the American Heart Association, American College of Physicians, and American Society of Echocardiography. He is also serving a two-year term (2007 – 2009) as a New York State Representative of the American College of Cardiology.

Before joining BMG, Dr. Luisi was an Assistant Professor of Medicine at UB and director of the University Ambulatory Nuclear Cardiology Laboratory. He has expertise in nuclear cardiac imaging including clinical and investigational positron emission tomography (PET).

Dr. Luisi is a member of the volunteer faculty in the UB Department of Medicine, and a member of the Medical School's Admissions Committee.

Over the past several years, He has presented research findings at many national and international cardiology meetings and has published studies in peer-reviewed journals.

Dr. Luisi is primarily affiliated with Buffalo General and Millard Fillmore Suburban hospitals, and his BMG offices will be at 295 Essjay Road, Williamsville, and 85 High Street in Buffalo.
